

# ECONOMIC IMPACTS





Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC) is an important contributor to the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) and the Alaska economies and is a critical link between Alaska communities, U.S. and international destinations. The economic impacts of ANC for FY2011 are presented in this brochure, painting a true picture of the important role ANC has on employment, earnings, spending, projects and more for the State of Alaska.

#### **Employment & Earnings**



#### **Government Revenues**

- At least \$2.3 million in property taxes to the MOA from businesses operating at ANC
- \$101.2 million in operating & investment revenues for the International Airport Revenue Fund (Landing fees made up 37% or \$37.5 million in total revenue)

1 in Anchorage is directly or indirectly related to ANC

#### **Spending on Goods & Services**

- ANC spends over \$12 million annually on locally provided goods and services
  - \*does not include utilities or construction related spending
- Public infrastructure construction projects at ANC generated 1,078 jobs and \$54 million in earnings

#### **Aviation Activity**

- ANC received 92,684 aircraft landings in FY2011
- ANC saw over 5 million passengers and more than 5.75 billion pounds of freight

#### **Linking Anchorage**
