## Small Detour When Leaving Airport Installation of Railroad Bridge at Airport Should Not Delay Travelers

Anchorage, June 10, 2002 -- Starting tomorrow, travelers will experience a small detour as they leave the South (Domestic) terminal of Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport east bound on International Airport Road. There will be no impact on people arriving at the Airport.

The short detour will continue through the week while the Alaska Railroad installs a railroad bridge over the eastbound lanes of International Airport Road. Users of the Airport should not be delayed or inconvenienced by the detour.

The bridge is scheduled to be placed into position on Thursday June 13<sup>th</sup> by three large cranes. All traffic should be back to normal late Friday the 14<sup>th</sup>.
