Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport and ACVB Ready To Welcome Tourists

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska) — The Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport in conjunction with the Anchorage Convention and Visitors Bureau (ACVB) is preparing to welcome tourists and visitors exploring Alaska every summer.

ACVB has three Visitor Information Centers (VIC) at the airport staffed by 50 volunteers, to offer travelers a convenient place to find information about Anchorage and the surrounding areas. The VIC's offer brochures, maps and directions along with information on sightseeing, dining and other area attractions. Additionally, the volunteers answer many general airport questions and assist travelers as needed. Last summer they assisted more than 35,000 people.

"We appreciate the ACVB volunteers who regularly perform this service and assist visitors to Alaska at our airports," said Christine Klein, Deputy Commissioner of Aviation of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities. "Currently the Anchorage airport volunteers are ramping up for summer with orientations in preparation for the tourist season."
