



Copper River Public Access: where you can go and where you can't



The Copper River cannot be accessed by the general public from all locations along the Copper River Highway. Please note which areas are public and which areas are private before you head out.

All uplands on both banks are privately owned. The highway right-of-way and lands below ordinary high water are the only public access available. Public access to the Copper River near O'Brien Creek is limited to pedestrian and all terain vehicle (ATV) and off-highway vehicle (OHV) access only. A public boat launch is located on the east bank below McCarthy Road.





Woodcutting is prohibited. Make sure campfires are out prior to leaving and always pack your garbage out. Thank you!
