The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Southeast Region (SER) Planning Staff recently released the Southeast Alaska Transportation Plan (SATP) 2011 Update Scoping Report and held a round of public meetings in 20 communities. You are receiving this newsletter because you either attended a meeting or submitted a comment. We appreciate your participation.

Through this process we received 167 written comments and numerous additional verbal comments. While we don't have the resources to respond to each and every comment, we have read them all and are using them to prepare and strengthen the Draft SATP.
